Canine Massage Therapist General Terms for participating in the Programme

Registration

- A student may apply to the Canine Intensive Programme by completing and signing the application form and sending it to the Woofs & Hoofs School of Animal Massage by post.
- By applying to the Programme, the student indicates his/her full acceptance of these General Terms.
- The terms apply to both parties upon the student's acceptance into the Programme.
- The student will receive confirmation of acceptance into the Programme by e-mail, as well as a syllabus of the first lesson and the Programme lesson dates.
- Admission applications are processed in the order they are received.
- The student's name, e-mail or address details may be used internally to keep the student informed of other activities presented by the Woofs & Hoofs School of Animal Massage or any changes to the Programme.
- The student is required to inform the Woofs & Hoofs School of Animal Massage of any changes to his/her (address) details in a timely manner.

Financial Agreements

- The full Programme fee or per module payment must be received on the account indicated on the invoices a minimum of five days prior to the start of the Programme or relevant module. Payments by cash or check are not accepted.
- The Woofs & Hoofs School of Animal Massage reserves the right to exclude students in the event of non-payment or late payment, in so far as exclusion is justifiable.

Cancellation

- By applying to the Programme, the student indicates his/her intention to attend and complete the entire programme for which the student has applied.

- The student may only cancel their registration in the Programme by registered mail. The cancellation date will be determined based on the postmark.
- If the student cancels his/her registration in the Programme up to two months prior to the start of the course, a cancellation fee of € 45 will be charged for administration costs.
- If the student cancels his/her registration in the Programme up to one month prior to the start of the course, a cancellation fee of five percent (5%) of the entire course fee, equal to € 225, plus € 45 for administration costs will be due.
- If the student cancels his/her registration in the Programme within one month prior to the start of the course, a cancellation fee of twenty-five percent (25%) of the entire course fee, equal to € 1125, plus € 45 for administration costs will be due.
- If the student cancels his/her registration in the Programme on or after the planned start date of the Programme, a cancellation fee of the full Programme fee, equal to € 4500, plus € 45 for administration costs will be due.
- A cancellation fee will not be charged in the event of the student's death.

Liability Insurance During the Programme

- The student participates in the course at his/her own risk and must have proper personal liability insurance/cover during the entire duration of the Programme.
- The student must be comfortable in the presence of dogs (canines) and is aware of/understands general safety standards when working with dogs and will act accordingly. The student shall also follow all safety instructions and guidelines indicated by Woofs & Hoofs School of Animal Massage staff and/or instructors.
- Neither the Woofs & Hoofs School of Animal Massage nor any of its staff or representatives may be held responsible for harm caused while massaging dogs which took place during or outside of the practical lessons of the Programme.

Programme Content, Copyright and Property Rights of Course Materials

- The Woofs & Hoofs School of Animal Massage will provide training and materials in subjects relating to the application of massage techniques to the canine client.
- The student agrees to complete any additional courses/requirements necessary to obtain their license and practice canine massage in their desired country/location.

- The student may not hold the Woofs & Hoofs School of Animal Massage or any of its representatives liable for costs resulting from any additional courses/requirements as mentioned above or otherwise.
- The Woofs & Hoofs School of Animal Massage retains all copyrights and property rights of the course materials provided and presented.

- Laws, rules and regulations can change without advance notice and may affect how an animal massage practitioner may call himself/herself and their profession, whether a massage practitioner is able to perform massage on animals, whose presence is required during the massage and which techniques may be used. It is also possible that courts or licensing authorities may interpret these laws, rules, and regulations in a way, which may affect animal massage.
- It is the sole responsibility of the student to determine and abide by the rules, laws and regulations that apply in the municipalities, jurisdictions, provinces, counties, towns, states, or countries where they intend to practice animal massage.
